

## Under Graduate Intermediate Examinations, 2020

1. Which Examinations are to be considered as intermediate examinations, 2020 and those to be conducted between 23rd November to 23rd December, 2020?

- (i) B.A./B.Sc. /B.Com. Part I Examinations (under 1+1+1 system).
- (ii) B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Part II Examinations (under 1+1+1 system).
- (iii) B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Semesters II Examinations, 2020 under CBCS.
- (iv) B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Semesters IV Examinations, 2020 under CBCS.
- (v) B.Com. Semester I/III/V Examinations for candidates already cleared B.Com. Semester VI Examination,2020.

2. Who are the candidates eligible to appear in intermediate examinations, 2020 as per UGC guidelines?

- All candidates appearing as a whole in B.A./B.Sc. /B.Com. Part I and Part II Examinations or B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Semesters II and Semester IV Examinations (all fresh candidates), as per relevant CSR.
- All candidates who have previously failed in one or more papers/ subjects (as the case may be) either in B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Part I or Part II or both, but have cleared B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Part III examinations.
- All candidates who have not cleared one or more subjects/courses of previous B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Semester II/ IV examinations **or** failed to appear in any of their previous B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. even Semester examinations.
- All candidates who have failed in one or more subjects/courses of previous B.Com. Semester I/III/V examinations **or** could not appear in any of their previous B.Com. odd Semester examinations **and already cleared B.Com. Semester VI Examination, 2020.**

3. How to generate marks?

- For B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Part I examination and B.Com Semester I examination, for all components 100% of the total assessment should be through internal evaluation conducted by the Colleges.
- For B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Part II, Semester II and Semester IV examinations and B.Com. Semester III and V examinations, for all components considered separately viz. theoretical/ practical/tutorial/internal assessment (as the case may be), 50 % of the total assessment should be through internal evaluation conducted by the Colleges

and remaining 50% on the basis of performance in previous semester/year. Full attendance will be given to candidates in the award list that will be generated.
